## NetLinks

### Installation and Configuration

Your NetLink configurations will be either set by your System Administrator, or provided to you by your System Administrator. If you are required to manually setup, the *Pre-installed and Non-configured* section reviews the necessary steps to setup and run your application. If your configuration has been set by your System Administrator, the *Pre-installed and Configured* section reviews the necessary steps to run your application.

If NetLink is not installed on your computer, there are two methods from which to acquire access. The first is through Java Web Start, in which your System Administrator will provide you with a URL from which you can remotely access a pre-configured NetLink, this is covered in the section *Java Web Start*. The second method is to download NetLink from the XVT website, this is covered in the *NetLink Download* section.

## Utilizing NetLinks

There are **four** methods through which to access NetLinks:

### Pre-installed and Non-configured

The Netlink application will be accessible through a desktop icon. When the icon is selected:

- The NetLink window will open and display a Connect Dialog box.
- Close the Connect Dialog box.
- Select the NetLink drop-down menu and choose Options.
- Make the necessary changes in the Options menu (Changes will be provided by your System Admin).
- After choosing your configuration, press OK.
- Re-open the Connect Dialog box by selecting the NetLink drop-down menu and choosing.
- Make Connection--this will re-open the Connect Dialog box.
- In the Enter Host Name/Address, enter your host address (e.g., 10.18.0.1).
- After inputting your host address, press OK. Your application should load after a short loading process.

### Pre-installed and Configured

The NetLink application should be accessible through a desktop icon. When the icon is selected:

- The NetLink window will open and display a Connect Dialog box.
- Input the Host Name/Address provided by your System Administrator.
- After inputting your host address, press OK. Your application should load after a short loading process.

### Java Web Start Configuration

To load your application, simply:

- Acquire the pre-configured Web address from your System Administrator--it may just be a link.
- Input the Web address into an Internet Browser, this should connect you to your application.

### XVT Site Download

To download NetLink and run your application:

- Access the XVT website, at xvt.com.
- Hover over the Products tab at the top of the home page.
- Choose the Netlink download page.
- Choose the NetLink download link that corresponds to your your specific operating system.
- NetLink's installation process with be unique to the operating system you are using.
- After the installation process, run NetLink.
- Installation and Configuration specs will be provided by your System Administrator.
